


WENSLEY ROAD, READING

MILEPAVE[™]

Reading Borough Council has led the way in carbon reduction, achieving a 54% drop in emissions since 2005. The borough now boasts the lowest per capita emissions in Berkshire, below both the South East and UK averages.



Delivered Programme of Work:

- Sector 6,241m² of Milepave™ Concrete Overlay
- ♣ 3,606m² of Milepave™ on flexible existing surface
- S3.14 tCO₂e total emissions

Environmental Savings:

- Savings of 106.74 tonnes in aggregates and 15 tonnes in straight run bitumen over conventional materials
- 33.14 tCO₂e saving over using a conventional warm mix material and a non-carbon neutral surfacing contractor
- Increased performance and subsequent lower whole life carbon costs

Financial Saving:

Designed system to last longer, address specific issues and ensure lower whole life cost
